





FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends and Supporters,

As we reflect on 2024, I am filled with deep gratitude. It was a year where our community embraced the power of unity, storytelling, and action, and turned it into tangible progress to transform the future of sarcoma diagnosis and treatment. This mission is deeply personal for so many of us, and every milestone we reach brings more hope to patients, families, and the future of sarcoma care.



Our 2024 theme, "We Are the Voices of Hope," was more than a rallying cry; it came to life in powerful ways. Nearly 1,000 participants, volunteers, and corporate partners helped raise \$262,000 at our annual Sarcoma Stomp, making it one of our most impactful events to date. In June, we unveiled the Seasons of Life installation at Levine Cancer Institute, the first permanent piece in our Growing Hope Through Art program, a lasting message of resilience and renewal for everyone who walks those halls.

We were deeply honored by the continued and growing support from our partners. The Clayton Baker Golf Tournament, organized by EY employees in memory of their beloved colleague, contributed \$230,000 to the Paula Takacs Foundation this September. Our long-standing partner, All In To Fight Cancer, has provided us with \$160,000 in lifetime giving through their poker tournament events, an incredible legacy of generosity and impact.

These efforts helped make possible the largest grant in our foundation's history: \$345,000 to Levine Cancer Institute and Levine Children's Hospital to support bold sarcoma research and launch the pilot year of our Emergency Financial Assistance Program. This initiative provided direct aid to patients across 10 major hospital systems in North Carolina, helping with essential needs like housing, food, utilities, and transportation. This expansion represents a meaningful evolution in how we walk alongside families facing sarcoma, through groundbreaking research and real-time support.

As we look toward 2025, we're energized by what's ahead. Our team is in the planning stages to launch the second installation of the Growing Hope Through Art program and deepen community-building through new social events. We will continue to fund innovative, life-changing research, and we are exploring a new initiative to offer tailored resources to sarcoma patients and caregivers from the moment of diagnosis. We're also proud to introduce our newest tradition, the Champions Celebration, an annual gathering to honor the incredible donors and partners who fuel our mission.

Together, we are advancing something extraordinary: bold sarcoma research that opens global pathways to better treatments and faster diagnoses. Every story shared, every dollar raised, and every partnership formed fuels this progress. Thank you for standing with us and for being part of a mission that is bringing real hope to patients, families, and the future of sarcoma care.

Your continued support is opening bold new frontiers in sarcoma research. Every discovery brings us closer to more effective treatments and brighter futures for those affected by this rare disease.

Unlocking the Biology of Synovial Sarcoma Protocol #: LCI-LCI-SAR-SYN-001

By analyzing archived tumor samples from patients dating back to 2009, researchers identified key genetic drivers linked to the spread of synovial sarcoma. The study explores the role of epithelial to mesenchymal transition in metastasis risk.

- Presented at the 2023 and 2024 international CTOS conferences.
- First manuscript is now in preparation for journal submission.

New Clinical Trial: Metformin in Advanced Sarcoma Treatment

Protocol #: ONC-SAR-2401

Synovial sarcoma tumors often use oxidative phosphorylation, an energy production method, to grow and spread. A new clinical trial will study whether Metformin, a widely used and well-tolerated diabetes drug, can block this process and improve outcomes when paired with standard chemotherapy.

- Protocol has been finalized and submitted to the FDA.
- Anticipated to open for patient enrollment in late 2025 or early 2026—pending IRB approval.

Circulating Tumor DNA: Advancing Blood-Based Monitoring for Sarcoma

Protocol #: LCI-SAR-BSTS-ctDNA-001

This prospective study will evaluate whether tumor DNA can be detected in blood samples, offering a real-time, non-invasive method to monitor disease and treatment response.

 Awaiting IRB approval, with plans to begin patient enrollment in 2025.

Early Detection Through Urine Testing Raman Spectroscopy Molecular Urinalysis

Raman spectroscopy—a light-based technology—has shown early success in detecting sarcoma in animal models.

 A new human study will test whether this portable, inexpensive, non-invasive method can be used to detect osteosarcoma in patients.

Growing Tumors in the Lab to Personalize Treatment Protocol #: LCI-SAR-Organoid-001

Scientists are developing a bank of 3D organoid models—miniature tumors grown from patient samples—to study drug resistance, immunotherapy, and personalized treatments.

- Now collaborating with Wake Forest to test promising therapies.
- Aims to build a foundation for precision medicine in sarcoma care.



NEW INITIATIVES WITH TANGIBLE IMPACT



In 2024, the Paula Takacs Foundation proudly advanced its mission by launching two major initiatives designed to bring healing, hope, and relief to those impacted by sarcoma. These efforts were made possible by our generous donor community and reflect our desire and commitment to surround sarcoma patients and their families with hope through healing environments, financial relief, and a community that cares deeply.

Growing Hope Through Art

Seasons of Life, Blown Glass Art Installation: A Living Tribute to Those Touched by Cancer

This year, we debuted our first public art installation, Seasons of Life, at Levine Cancer Institute. This is the first project in our **Growing Hope Through Art** fund raising program. Created by artist Jake Pfeifer of Hot Glass Alley, this vibrant glass tree sculpture brings color, comfort, and beauty to all who pass through the space. More than art, it's a celebration of life, resilience, and the enduring strength of the sarcoma community.

A unique component of this program is donor engagement. Individuals can dedicate blossoms in honor or memory of loved ones touched by cancer, creating a lasting tribute while directly supporting sarcoma research. All proceeds fund critical local research to accelerate better treatments and outcomes.

Emergency Financial Assistance ProgramHelping Sarcoma Patients Overcome Financial Barriers to Treatment

In 2024 we secured funding to launch the Sarcoma Fund, a pilot financial assistance program in partnership with **Family Reach**, a national nonprofit dedicated to supporting families facing the financial burdens of cancer. While the Sarcoma Fund officially began assisting families in early 2025, it was fully funded by generous contributions raised in 2024, allowing us to hit the ground running and provide immediate support to families in need.

The program currently supports patients being treated at major North Carolina cancer centers, including Duke, UNC, Atrium Health, and Wake Forest Baptist, covering essential non-medical costs such as rent or mortgage, utilities, groceries, and transportation to treatment

By eliminating financial stressors, this program helps ensure patients can stay on their treatment plans and focus on healing, not hardship. The Sarcoma Fund also includes access to Family Reach's Financial Resource Center for coaching and planning support.

"While our mission remains rooted in funding local research, expanding global hope, and amplifying awareness, we recognize that financial hardships can create barriers to treatment.
